Answers:

Q1: A = 7, B = 2. The centre number is the difference between the two numbers at the end of each rod.

Q2: A = 7, B = 13 & C = 12. In Box A the bottom numbers are a third of the top numbers. In Box B the bottom number is 7 less than the top, and in Box C the bottom number is half the top one.
